Culture Day Tuesday 17th September

Next Tuesday students and staff will be engaged in a whole day devoted to celebrating the cultural diversity within the SHSG school community. As such, there is a whole host of activities which have been planned ranging from dance to having an introduction to a new language and learning about particular traditions within different cultures. Students as well as staff are taking the lead on delivering the activities and we would like to also thank those parents who have volunteered to give up their time to support this day by leading activities.

The culture day will be a non uniform day so that we can invite students to wear cultural dress. Please note that students in Years 7-10 will be off timetable all day; students in Year 11 will be off timetable in the afternoon (lessons 4 and 5) only; and students in Years 12 and 13 will be off timetable in the morning (lessons 1 and 2) only. We are very much looking forward to what promises to be a very enjoyable day. European Under 20s Athletics – championship record

At the end of July, Shiloh travelled to Slovakia to represent Great Britain in the European Under 20s competition. The team qualified comfortably for the finals of the medley relay and Shiloh ran the anchor leg. She ran such a strong leg on the relay and brought the team back into bronze medal position. This broke the national championship record as well as being a national U18 record.





Year 11 Careers consultations

As part of our Careers curriculum, we offer all Year 11 students the opportunity to have a one-to-one, in person 40-minute careers consultation with an independent advisor from careers specialists, 'Connexions'. This gives students the opportunity to consider their post-16 and wider ambition options.

The first interviews took place this week with more to follow across the autumn term. Year 11 students should check their emails for their invitation and are also advised to also double check with their form tutor or Careers Coordinator, Ms Casson.
